# Timeline at a Glance

- Application Release Date: June 23, 2026, at 12:00PM
- Application Due Date: Rolling date with submissions due the last day of each month
- Award Notifications: Awards will occur the month following application submissions
- Deadline for 2026: To be considered for 2026 funding, applications must be submitted no later than October 31, 2026

# Eligible Use of Funds

- Community events
- New or expanded organizational programming
- Innovative or pilot community-based projects
- Community-based activities

# Ineligible Use of Funds

- Political or advocacy activities
- Capital campaigns or renovations
- Organizational infrastructure or capacity-building
- Activities that have already occurred
- Fundraising events or sponsorships
- Staff compensation/salaries

# APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- Register in Fluxx—the grants software platform
- Submit your application at least 30 days prior to the activation of your idea
- Applications are due no later than the last day of the month, on a rolling basis
- Any or part of the application received after 5:00PM EST on last day of month will not be reviewed during the current review period

# AWARD NOTIFICATIONS AND PAYMENTS

- Award notifications will be emailed to the applicant the following month the application is submitted.
- Award notifications will include an award letter and a funded partner grant agreement that will need to be signed by both the Executive Director / President & Chief Executive Officer and the Board Chair and returned to the Foundation.
- The full grant payment will be issued to the grantee or fiscal agent once the executed award agreement has been fully executed and returned to the Foundation.

# Timeline at a Glance

- **Application Release Date:** June 23, 2026, at 12:00PM
- **Application Due Date:** August 17, 2026, by 5:00PM EST
- **Award Notifications:** Month of November 2026
- **Funding Dispersed:** No later than December 2026
- **In-Person Presentations:** August 11-12, 2026, 30-minute timeslots via bookings link
- **Project Period:** 1-year starting December 2026 and ending December 2027

# Eligible Use of Funds

- Personnel and Program Staffing
- Participant Support and Program Supplies
- Technology and Program Operations

# Ineligible Use of Funds

- No political activities
- No vehicle purchases
- No capital expenditures involving property
- No debt reduction
- No fundraising expenses
- No piloting a new program

# ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Must have an active 501(c)3, 509(a)1, or 509(a)(3) designation as determined by IRS
- No minimum amount of time as a designated active organization; however, you must have active status prior to submission of application.
- There is no minimum or maximum annual operating budget required; however, to generate equitable access to these funds, two stratifications of organizational size will be created.
- You are not eligible to receive these funds if you have a current grant with FHSP greater than \$50,000

# SUBMISSION OPTIONS

- Written Submission
- Video Submission
- In-Person at FHSP or Zoom Submission

# WRITTEN SUBMISSIONS

- Entire application submitted in writing.
- A character count limit will be noted for each section of the application.

# VIDEO SUBMISSIONS

- Short videos for each section of the application indicating this submission option.
- A total of 5 videos may be submitted
- A time limit is noted for each section of the application that allows for video submission.
- Some portions of application require written submission.

# IN PERSON OR ZOOM SUBMISSIONS

- In-person or zoom for each section of the application indicating this submission option.
- A total of 5 sections may be submitted
- You must request a 30-minute appointment at FHSP Office
- A time limit is noted for each section of the RFP that allows for in-person submission.
- Some portions of application require written submission.



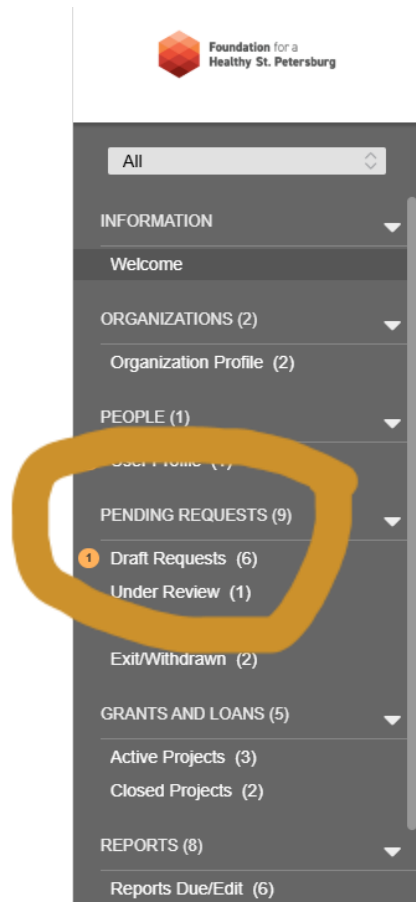
