CAPACITY-BUILDING GRANTS

THE GATHERING OF WOMEN INC.

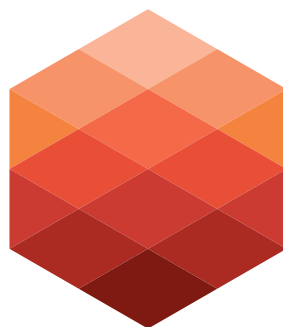
